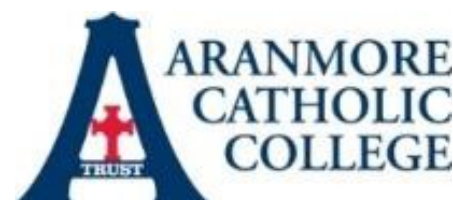

Trials & Team Selections

A little bit of work was put into the trialing & team selection process for 2016 to ensure a fair & transparent process for all players throughout Junior & Open teams. This included where possible blind numbered trials, independent selectors & the adoption of a more unified players grading which streamlined our selection process. I think all in all the Committee & Coaches did a fantastic job in completing the process once again in a timely & professional manner. For discussion at the AGM would be the possibility of starting our trialing & selection process earlier (mid-February) to enable more time for team cohesion prior to the season start. We will be endeavoring to line up with some of the other PNA clubs for some round robin match play prior to the season commencement on a Wednesday night.

Grading

We thought that most of our teams were graded correctly through the first & second round grade.

Season Summary

It was noted that we had no teams collect any premierships or qualify for a grand final in 2016; this is in fact the first year in the Club's history. An overall look at the final placings has shown that we are still aligned with the overall placing within the competitions from previous seasons and we have a higher median placing than 2015.

It will be important to remember that whilst we have had a reduction in team numbers and players in 2016 due to the Competition restrictions we will be limited to our total number of teams moving into 2017.

The adoption of mature age coaches in our younger age groups helped to provide stability and will help to foster strong foundations for our Club players in the younger age groups.

We were delighted with her knowledge that helped to harmonize the continuation of our elite playing group and saw great value further flowing through our senior playing group.

A special thank you to Jorjena Harman who took on the role of Junior team 1 coach after a re-grade forced a clash amongst the playing coaches. This required Jorje to take on two teams for the remainder of the season which was greatly appreciated and was a seamless transition for the team.

As always our coaches lead from the front and always upheld our Club's code of behaviors to the highest standard and asked that of their teams as well. Thank you once again and congratulations on helping to drive such a successful season.
