Life Membership Criteria

Life Membership is the highest award available to recognise the exceptional contribution of individuals to the Aranmore Jets Netball Club. It is therefore only to be awarded in exceptional circumstances.

1. General Considerations

In considering the award of Life Membership an individual should have demonstrated significant, sustained and high quality service enhancing the reputation and future of the Club.

The points to be taken into account when considering any nomination should include:

- The general attitude and overall demeanour of the nominee to ensure that the attitude is one that reflects a dedication to the values of the AJNC
- Commitment to the principals of good sportsmanship
- Valued leadership and good role modelling that reflects credit upon AJNC.

2. Length of Service

- The length of service to the Club should be at least 10 years.
- The nominee should have served on the committee for at least 5 years
- This service must have reflected favourably and brought credit upon the Aranmore Jets Netball Club.

3. Other Criteria to be considered

- Must be a current financial member.
- Must have made outstanding contributions to the club in the position in one or more of: coach, umpire, player and/or administration

Benefits of Life Membership

- Exemption from fees associated with AJNC presentation events
- Listing in the Netball Club website and other official documents

Retraction of Life Membership

Retraction of a Life Membership Award may occur where the recipient has conducted him/herself in a manner that reflects directly and adversely on the image or activities of the Netball Club. This provision will only be exercised in exceptional circumstances and will require the full support of the AJNC Committee.

As part of the deliberations, the Life Member in question is also to be given an opportunity to present their case for retention of their Life Membership status.
